The Greenstone Trail

This is one of New Zealand's most unspoilt regions and our tour is full of attractions that cover many of the 'must see and do's' of Westland, which we cover from top to bottom. Have you ever walked among the treetops in a South Westland Rainforest or been wowed by the reflections at Lake Matheson? Walked on the Heaphy track, visited the glaciers or explored the secret waterways of Okarito in search of the sacred white heron? No? Then what are you waiting for?

Read a sample of the itinerary:

White Herons and West Coast Rainforest

We travel south to Whataroa this morning to join White Heron Sanctuary Tours for a very special experience. Travelling across farmland, we then walk to a hide through pristine rainforest in the Waitangi Roto Nature Reserve to view NZ's only kotuku (white heron) sanctuary. Revered by the Maori as a symbol of beauty, the white heron is rare in NZ and breeds only in this secret location. The birds are nesting, so you will also see young birds, making this a truly magical and privileged experience.

Wairarapa Off the Beaten Track

Join us as we get off the beaten track to showcase Wairarapa's wild coast, iconic stations, historic homesteads, wines and foods. There is much to see in this scenic region if you take the time, heading over that hill or taking that country road. This short tour is packed with something to appeal to everyone.

Coastal Country

Today we take a scenic drive to the Castlepoint coast where we enjoy a leisurely walk up to the iconic lighthouse which was built in 1913 and is one of the last two remaining beam lighthouses in New Zealand. We then meet with the owners of Castlepoint Station for an introductory talk, before enjoying the privilege of travelling in our coach over the Otahome Road which passes through the breathtaking coastal scenery of Castlepoint Station. Driving towards Riversdale, we stop at the wonderful Homewood Storeroom Restaurant for a relaxing roast lunch prepared by Chef Paddy who incorporates ingredients from the farm, including lamb.

Watch the cows being milked and enjoying a massage with a whirly brush, while you learn all about this very different approach to conventional dairy farming. Don't miss "Poppa's Shed", a collection of vintage farm machinery. Lunch today is at the Coach House Museum in Feilding, then after lunch there will be time to wander the museum, an outstanding collection of rural history, farm equipment and horse drawn transport.

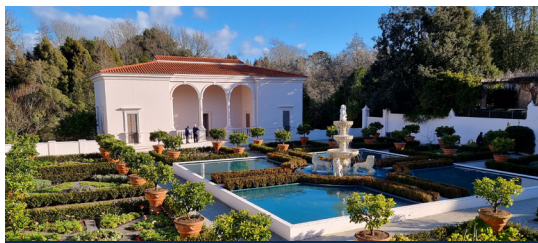
